WHAT IS A "PRO"?

-I'M NOT NECESSARILY TALKING ABOUT FAMOUS DRUMMERS. I'M TALKING ABOUT ANY OF THE "JOURNEYMAN" PLAYERS WHO QUIETLY TAKE CARE OF BUSINESS. THERE ARE CERTAIN LESSONS THAT YOU LEAR WITH EXPERIENCE.

LESSON 1 - RIMSHOTS

- -IF YOU WANT TO PLAY ANY AMPLIFIED MUSIC LIKE ROCK OR FUNK. RIMSHOTS ARE A MUST.
- -EVEN IF YOU DON'T PLAY LOUDLY, THEY'RE A GOOD TOOL TO CREATE CLEANLINESS AND TEXTURE, (SEE TRANSCRIPTION)

LESSON 2 - BEAT PLACEMENT

- -THE CONSISTENCY OF VOLUME AND "PLACEMENT IN TIME" OF BEATS IS A "HIDDEN SKILL"
- -RECORD YOURSELF PLAYING WITH A SONG AND LISTEN/LOOK AT THE WAVE FORMS. ARE YOUR BEATS CONSISTENT?
- -STEVE JORDAN IS THE MASTER OF THIS. (MORE DETAIL)

LESSON 3 - TUNING

- -IT'S NOT ABOUT "ONE PERFECT TUNING", BUT RATHER BEING ABLE TO MAKE THE DRUMS SOUND GOOD FOR WHAT YOU WANT THEM TO DO.
- -SNARE TUNING LUGS IN TUNE WITH THEMSELVES, BOTTOM HEAD IN TUNE IS THE 80/20
- -TOM TUNING MY VIDEO HERE GOES INTO GREATER DETAIL

LESSON 4 - FLOW

- -THIS IS A "HARD PROBLEM", BUT I HAVE TO BE HONEST THIS *IS* A BIG DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PROS AND BEGINNERS
- -WAY MORE DETAIL IN THIS VIDEO.

LESSON 5 - CONDUCTING THE BAND

- -MUSIC SOCIAL SKILLS ARE ONE OF THE MOST UNDERRATED SKILLS OF "PROS"
- -SUBSKILL 1 "CONDUCTING" THE BAND WITH YOUR PLAYING
- -SUBSKILL 2 "CONDUCTING" THE BAND WITH BODY LANGUAGE, GESTURES, AND EYE-CONTACT
